Entry Requirements

You will normally need to have at least one of the following:

- 1) A BTEC First Certificate or Diploma in a related subject.
- 2) An Intermediate GNVQ in a related subject.
- 3) At least 4 GCSE's at grades A – C.
- 4) Appropriate work experience.

Course Description

A BTEC National Award is a practical, work related course. You learn by completing projects and assignments that are based on realistic workplace situations, activities and demands. You focus on a particular subject area and develop a range of specialist skills and knowledge. It is equivalent to one A level so when you have finished the course you can use it to get employment, or further your career if you are already employed. It can also be used alongside other qualifications to enter higher education.

A BTEC National Award is normally taken part-time alongside other qualifications or by people in employment and is equally suitable for school leavers and mature students.

All students take the two core units:

Unit 1: Sport In Society

Unit 2: Ethics and Values In Sport

Plus 4 specialist units from the selected pathway:

Assessment

All units are assessed and graded, and an overall grade for the qualification is awarded.

Career Opportunities

If you wanted to gain employment straight away you could work in:

- 1) Sports Centres
- 2) Leisure Centres
- 3) Outdoor Activities Centres

If you decide to go to University or College and you have other qualifications, you could take a degree or a BTEC Higher National in subjects such as:

- 1) Sports Studies
- 2) Leisure Management
- 3) Recreation Management
- 4) Teacher training
